

# Exploratory Worksheet

You've decided to use the relational economies activity to explore some of the practices and values your group members are interested in. Great!

Maybe you're in transition and thinking about new ways to organise, or maybe things have been going great, but the excitement is waning. This activity is meant to support you in a collective exploration of possibilities within relational economies.

## Instructions

In each row you can list the two cards you're connecting and the connections you came up with. Put one card title in the left bubble, one card title in the right bubble and your notes on connection in the central most bubble.
